Motion to approve the Agenda. Motion was made by Friedman and second by Siwecki. Motion carried with four (4) ayes and zero (0) nays.

Motion was made to approve the Minutes from the August 11, 2021 regular meeting. Motion was made by Dawson and second by Friedman. Motion carried with four (4) ayes and zero (0) nays.

New Business:


1. Honoring of Angel O'Dell for her donations of \$425 towards a park bench for one of our parks.
